



On Friday June 5, 2020, the province entered the second part of the yellow recovery phase. Under the second part of this yellow phase, several additional businesses and organizations are now permitted to open under the current Mandatory Order dated June 5, 2020. This yellow phase applies to all zones in the Province of New Brunswick with the exception of zone 5, the Campbellton region, which remains in Orange Phase of recovery.

Regardless if you are in the yellow phase of recovery or the orange phase of recovery, all agents and REALTORS® are required to comply with the following:

- Have an operational plan in place that is in compliance with guidelines from WorkSafe NB and the NB Chief Medical Officer of Health. REALTORS® may follow the operational plan of their representative agent. NBREA has issued guideline document which can be found on our website at www.nbrea.ca and which may help you prepare your own operational plan.
- All individuals entering New Brunswick must self-isolate for 14 days.
- All individuals should maintain physical distancing of 2 meters from persons with exception of: family and friends (if in yellow phase of recovery) or a 2 household bubble (if in orange phase of recovery).
- All individuals must wear a non-medical mask in any location other than their own home when physical distancing cannot be maintained.
