

New Brunswick home sales and listings plummet as social distancing measures and uncertainty take hold of market

The number of homes sold through the MLS® Systems of real estate Boards in New Brunswick totaled 472 units in April 2020. This was a large decline of 42.7% from April 2019 and put sales back at their lowest level for this month in more than 15 years.

On a year-to-date basis, home sales totalled 2,325 units over the first four months of the year. This was down 4.9% from 2019.

At the local level, home sales activity posted year-over-year declines in Saint John (-29.3%), the Northern Region (-45.3%), Greater Moncton (-46.7%), and Fredericton (-46.8%).

The average price of homes sold in New Brunswick was \$182,931 in April 2020, edging down 2.2% from April 2019.

The more comprehensive year-to-date average price was \$182,992, up 4.6% from the first four months of 2019.

There were 629 new residential listings added to the MLS® Systems of real estate Boards in New Brunswick in April 2020. This was a large decline of 58.6% on a year-over-year basis and marked the lowest April in more than 30 years.

Overall supply has trended down over the last five years and is now dropping more sharply. Active residential listings numbered 3,766 units at the end of April. This was down 29.7% from the end of April 2019 and marked the lowest level of supply on the market at the end of any April since 2004.

Months of inventory numbered 8 at the end of April 2020, up from the 6.5 months recorded at the end of April 2019 but still below the long-run average of 10 months for this time of year. The number of months of inventory is the number of months it would take to sell current inventories at the current rate of sales activity.

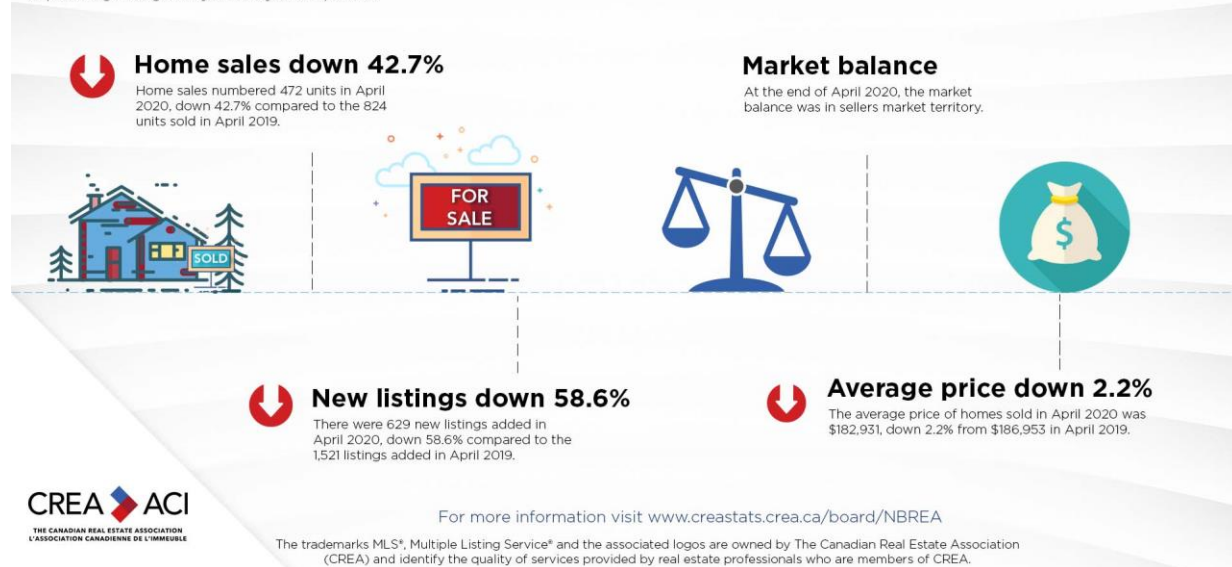
Important information
